



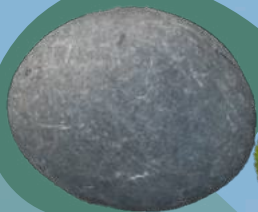

ACTIVITIES

At the JFK Swiss Outdoor Camp we offer multiple opportunities to explore and enjoy the alpine environment. With activities such as ziplining, canoeing and mountain climbing we provide a challenging and fun experience for students. Team building is also reinforced with group activities that encourage team participation. LEARN OUTDOORS

The JFK experience, involving environmental education, personal and social development, and adventure activities, connects learning at school and home. Students develop environmental awareness, essential life skills, and practical knowledge through this holistic approach. DISCOVER

The JFK experience can be linked to learning both at school and at home. Immerse in nature's embrace, students explore woods, streams, mountains, igniting their senses, fostering genuine learning in a captivating environment. Here, reality unveils, as students witness, touch, and listen, unearthing knowledge through nature's bounty.



THREE MAIN THEMES



MOUNTAIN

Hiking is a brilliant way to discover the alpine environment and life on the summer pastures. Students learn how to safely navigate the mountains using a map and compass and how weather conditions and equipment need to be considered for a successful adventure. Camping under the stars is also a magical experience and with the absence of light pollution, the Saanenland provides a fantastic opportunity to discover the Milky Way and study nocturnal life.



ROCK

Students are taught to safely climb in different outdoor environments, developing their skill and confidence throughout the week. They traverse across suspended walkways, zip-line through the air and abseil down mountains. They also discover the wonders of different rock formations, learning how they are made, the habit they provide and the best way to search for fossils and mountain animals.

Every week has a different theme: rock, water or mountain to ensure maximum learning and a full alpine experience.

WATER

Children will experience water activities such as canoeing, raft building and canyoning as well as exploring the flora and fauna of a river. Students are taught to survey a mountain stream, look for water animals and test water purity, velocity and temperature. Crossing a river will never be the same after this Summer.



NATURE

Outdoor learning is all about nature, learning through demonstration and doing. Touching and seeing is what it is all about.



ADVENTURE

The thrill of adventure is a great motivator, encouraging learning through exploration and discovery.



TEAMBUILDING

Teamwork teaches respect of others, how to build self esteem and creates lasting friendships.



LOCATION AND FACILITIES

The Camp offers separate boarding facilities for boys and girls in traditional Swiss chalets situated in the heart of the picturesque village of Saanen. On-site facilities include common areas, dormitories, private bathrooms, playing field/garden, sports equipment and indoor games. After an action-packed day of activities, the Houses provide a great place to relax with new friends and enjoy a barbeque or Swiss fondue.

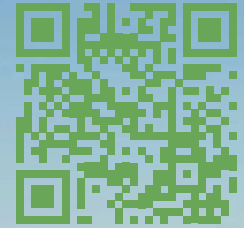
